### The Week Ahead

- The Blue Hose will be making their first trip to the Division I men's soccer NCAA Tournament. They made the Division II men's soccer NCAA Tournament in 1995.
- This is the school's second NCAA Tournament since moving to the Division I level as the men's tennis team also went to the NCAA Tournament in the spring of 2017.
- Presbyterian College will be facing the UNC Wilmington Seahawks in its First Round game. The Seahawks are 11-7-0 on the season and 1-1 in the month of November.
- PC and UNCW have played one time, in 2013 when the Blue Hose defeated the No. 24 Seahawks 2-1.

### Series History

#### UNCW: Presbyterian leads 1-0-0

The Blue Hose and Seahawks have faced each other once in the two programs history. That game was played in 2013 and the Blue Hose defeated the No. 24 ranked Seahawks 2-1.

The Blue Hose and Seahawks are playing for the right to move on and face North Carolina. If the Blue Hose are victorious it will mark their first game versus the Tar Heels in program history.

Jonathan Potter is entering his second season as head coach of the Presbyterian College men's soccer team in 2017.

In his first year at the helm, Potter guided the Blue Hose to a 7-10-3 overall record with a 4-4 mark in conference play. The seven wins marked the third biggest turnaround last season in NCAA DI and is the most wins in a season in program history. The No. 5 seed in the Big South Championship, PC upset fourth-seeded Liberty 2-1 on November 6 for the program's first ever victory in the conference tournament.

The Blue Hose faced top-seeded Radford in the program's first-ever semifinal appearance, falling to the Highlanders on penalty kicks after playing to a 1-1 draw in regulation. Potter saw four players earn annual awards, to include a pair making Second Team All-Big South, one Honorable Mention and an All-Freshman honoree.

Prior to PC, Potter spent five seasons at Elon as an assistant coach where he helped the Phoenix win five conference championships and several NCAA Tournament appearances, including advancing to the second round in 2013 and 2015.

Potter, who holds a "B" US Soccer Federation Coaching License and an advanced diploma from the NCSAA, also served as the director of men's soccer operations at Davidson College, where he assisted in training, filming, editing, and analysis.

A four-year starter at Chowan, Potter appeared in all but one match during his career. He holds a bachelor's degree in physical education with a concentration in sport management and a minor in business administration. He earned his master's degree in athletic coaching education from West Virginia University in 2012.

In 2009 he trained with a professional team in Argentina and prior to that, played in the United Soccer League with a Northern Virginia Royals' super-20 team that reached the 2008 North American finals.

Potter is married to the former Melissa Cochran of Macon, Ga.

## Scouting the Competition

### UNC Wilmington:



- UNC Wilmington comes into this NCAA Tournament game with an 11-7-0 record overall, they finished 5-3 in the Colonial Athletic Conference.

- They score 1.56 goals per game on a .140 shooting percentage while holding the opposition to 1.21 goals per game and a .150 shooting percentage. They have taken 78 corner kicks this season while limiting the opposition to 70.

- Phillip Goodrum leads the Seahawks with seven goals and four assists for 18 points this season. Emil Elveroth and Julio Moncada each have five goals and two assists for 12 points.

- Ryan Cretens has played all 1656:41 minutes in goal this season posting a 1.14 goals against average with a .650 save percentage and six shutouts.

- The Seahawks are led by 17 year veteran Aidan Heaney who has posted a 151-138-33 record at UNC Wilmington. With two prior seasons at Appalachian State he has a 172-152-33 career record in 19 seasons overall.

## Conference Champions

- On Sunday the Blue Hose won their fifth conference tournament championship, first at the Division I level. They were the South Atlantic Champions at the Division II level in 1991, 1993, 1995 and 1996.

- They made one NCAA appearance in 1995 following their South Atlantic Conference title. The Blue Hose then faced USC Spartanburg, now USC Upstate, in the NCAA Division II Tournament falling 2-0.

## Behrend in the Books

- Connor Behrend has been the most successful goalkeeper in PC's Division I era posting a .781 save percentage which ranks third in Big South history.

- He also holds PC records for career shutouts (10), single season shutouts (6), goalkeeper minutes played (3954), and wins (13). He is second in career saves with 196 putting him four away from 200.

## Youth Movement

- The freshmen make up the largest class for the team this season, with 16 on the roster.

- There are 15 freshmen and one redshirt freshman on the roster. Seven play defense, two play midfield, six play forward and one plays goalie.

- Eight of the fourteen players who have recorded a goal this season have been freshmen. Led by Clement Vannier with five goals and two assists for 12 points.

- The freshmen have combined to score 15 of the 23 goals and record 11 of the 19 assists this season.

## Vannier Setting Freshmen Records

- True freshman Clement Vannier leads the Blue Hose with five goals and two assists for 12 points.
- Both the five goals and 12 points are records for goals and points by a freshman in PC's Division I era. He is also the leading freshmen scorer in the Big South in goals (5) and points (12).

## Pinto, Hernandez and Three Freshmen Honored by Big South

- Sophomore midfielder Sergio Pinto was named to the Big South Second Team on Friday, November 3. He finished his sophomore regular season with three goals and three assists. Two of his three goals were game-winners and the other resulted in the Blue Hose's tie with Radford.
- Sophomore midfielder Ricardo Hernandez was named Big South All-Academic while Vannier, Adrian Edo Martin and Victor Menudier were named to the All-Freshman team.

## Blue Hose in the Post Season

- The Blue Hose are making their first trip to the Division I NCAA Tournament and second overall. They went to the 1995 Division II NCAA Tournament.
- At the Division I level PC has a 2-1-3 all-time record in post season play, all in three Big South Tournament trips. In 2012 PC was defeated by Coastal Carolina. PC would defeat Liberty in 2016 before falling in Penalty Kicks to Radford. In 2017 the Blue Hose would get their redemption versus Radford moving past them in Penalty Kicks in the Semi's as well as High Point in the Finals to advance to the NCAA's.
- This will be the Blue Hose's first game versus UNC Wilmington in the NCAA Tournament and second game ever versus the Seahawks.

## Hernandez Named Tournament MVP

- Ricardo Hernandez was named the Big South Tournament MVP. Sergio Pinto, Adrian Edo Martin and Connor Behrend were also named to the All-Tournament Team.

## Draws in a Single Season

- With the Blue Hose 0-0 tie on Sunday afternoon they have now set a new single season record for ties in a season with five. They are 6-8-5 overall now this season. If the Blue Hose and Seahawks go to overtime it will tie the single season record for overtime games at seven.

## Blue Hose Re-Writing The Record Book

- The Blue Hose have scored 23 goals and tallied 19 assists this season, both are single season team records at the Division I level.
- The Blue Hose have had four Big South Player of the Week honorees over the last two seasons, they had one all-time prior to 2016. Connor Behrend has been the recipient of three of the four honors over the last two seasons.
- PC has made marked improvement on the road this season after finishing 2-7-2 on the road in 2016 it is 4-3-4 in 2017.
