Offenses:
DOG ORDINANCE VIOLATION / DOG ATTACK

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIMES CLINTON UNITS WERE DISPATCHED TO THE AREA OF 106 GORDON ST IN RESPONSE TO A DOG ATTACK. LAURENS CENTRAL DISPATCH HAD ADVISED CLINTON UNITS THAT THE COMPLAINANT'S DOG HAD BEEN ATTACKED BY A PITBULL. PSO MERCER AND RECRUIT MENDOZA WERE THE FIRST TO ARRIVE ON SCENE, MAKING CONTACT WITH THE COMPLAINANT, TERESA GODFREY. MERCER AND MENDOZA LOCATED THE SUSPECT DOG, A TAN PITBULL, WHICH WAS IN FRONT OF 113 GORDON ST, ADJACENT TO THE INCIDENT LOCATION OF 106 GORDON ST. GODFREY ADVISED MERCER AND MENDOZA THAT SHE HAD BEEN ON HER PORCH, WHEN THE PITBULL CHARGED HER AND HER DOG, BRODY. AT THIS TIME I DID NOT HAVE ANY KNOWLEDGE THAT THE DOG HAD BEEN LOCATED AND WAS PATROLLING THE AREA. AS I CROSSED GORDON ST, MERCER ADVISED ME TO TURN LEFT ON TO GORDON ST. AS I TURNED ON TO GORDON ST, I OBSERVED A LARGE TAN PITBULL ON THE SIDEWALK IN FRONT OF 113 GORDON ST. GODFREY ADVISED CLINTON UNITS THAT THE OWNERS OF THE DOG LIVED AT 113 GORDON ST. WHEN I CALLED OUT ON SCENE, MERCER ADVISED ME THAT THE DOG WAS VICIOUS AND THAT HE HAD CHARGED AT HER AND MENDOZA SINCE THEY HAD BEEN ON SCENE. I OBSERVED MERCER AND MENDOZA ON THE PORCH SPEAKING WITH GODFREY AT 106 GORDON ST. I THEN UTILIZED MY PATROL VEHICLE EQUIPPED SPOT LIGHT AND RIGHT SIDE ALLEY LIGHT TO ILLUMINATE BOTH THE YARD AND THE FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE OF 113 GORDON ST, WHERE THE DOG WAS LOCATED. I ALSO HOPED THAT THE LIGHT SHINNING THROUGH THE WINDOWS OF THE RESIDENCE WOULD GET THE ATTENTION OF OCCUPANTS AND DRAW THEM OUTSIDE TO TAKE POSSESSION OF THEIR AGGRESSIVE DOG WHO WAS ROAMING FREELY. AT THIS TIME MERCER AND MENDOZA LEFT THE PORCH OF THE COMPLAINANT IN THE DIRECTION OF THEIR PATROL VEHICLE. I

OBSERVED THE DOG CHARGE TOWARDS THEM A SECOND TIME, AS THEY GOT BACK IN THEIR PATROL VEHICLE, IN ORDER TO PROTECT THEMSELVES FROM THE DOG. WITH GODFREY, AND NOW MERCER AND MENDOZA OUT OF HARMS WAY, I LOOKED UP ANY AND ALL CONTACT INFORMATION WE HAD AVAILABLE THROUGH THE LAWTRAK SYSTEM. I TRIED TO REACH SOMEONE ON TWO DIFFERENT NUMBERS ASSOCIATED WITH RESIDENTS OF 113 GORDON ST. LIEUTENANT WICKER ALSO ADVISED THAT HE ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THREE PHONE NUMBERS ASSOCIATED WITH THAT RESIDENCE, WITH NO RESULT, AS ALL NUMBERS HAD BEEN DISCONNECTED. BY THIS TIME, THE DOG HAD MOVED UP THE STREET TOWARDS ACADEMY ST, AND WAS NOW IN FRONT OF 111 GORDON ST. I FELT THAT THERE WAS NOW A SAFE ENOUGH DISTANCE BETWEEN THE DOG AND OFFICERS ON SCENE, TO ATTEMPT TO MAKE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE AT THE RESIDENCE TO WHICH THE DOG BELONGED. AS I EXITED MY PATROL VEHICLE AND CROSSED THE ROAD, THE DOG TURNED BACK AROUND, FACED ME AND BEGAN BARKING AGGRESSIVELY. THE DOG THEN SHOWED IT'S TEETH AND BEGAN TO CHARGE AT ME. I DREW MY DUTY WEAPON AND AIMED IT AT THE DOG AS I FEARED IMMINENT INJURY TO MY FELLOW OFFICERS ON SCENE AND MYSELF. I STEPPED OFF LINE OF THE DOG, TO THE RIGHT AS IT CONTINUED TO CHARGE ME IN AN AGGRESSIVE MANNER. DUE TO THE CLOSE PROXIMITY OF SURROUNDING RESIDENCES, I ALLOWED THE DOG TO CLOSE THE GAP BETWEEN US, BEFORE DISCHARGING FOUR WELL AIMED ROUNDS INTO THE FRONT AND LEFT SIDE OF THE DOG. THE DOG CONTINUED TO CHARGE AT ME THROUGH THE DURATION OF THE ROUNDS FIRED. AFTER STRIKING AND INJURING THE DOG, IT THEN RAN ACROSS THE STREET INTO THE FRONT YARD OF 108 GORDON ST, WHERE IT BEGAN TO SPIN IN CIRCLES VIOLENTLY DUE TO THE SEVERITY OF ITS INJURIES. AT THIS TIME I BEGAN TO RE-APPROACH THE DOG IN ORDER TO EUTHANIZE IT AND KEEP IT FROM SUFFERING ANY FURTHER. I OBSERVED THE DOG STILL GROWLING AGGRESSIVELY, AND SPINNING IN CIRCLES. AT THIS TIME THE DOG WAS IN THE DRIVEWAY OF 108 GORDON ST AND I WAS UNABLE TO DISCHARGE MY FIREARM TO END ITS SUFFERING, DUE TO THE SURROUNDING CONCRETE. AS I APPROACHED THE DOG FROM THE DIRECTION OF MY PATROL VEHICLE, IT AGGRESSIVELY CHARGED AT ME ONCE MORE, LEAVING THE CONCRETE DRIVEWAY, AND INTO THE GRASS, DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 108 GORDON ST. WITH MY DUTY WEAPON STILL DRAWN, THE DOG CLOSED IN ON ME AGAIN. ONCE THE DOG WAS CLOSE ENOUGH I FIRED FOUR WELL AIMED ROUNDS INTO THE DOG, IN A DOWNWARD DIRECTION, AS NOT TO STRIKE ANYTHING OTHER THAN THE DOG. AGAIN THE DOG CONTINUED TO CHARGE IN MY DIRECTION THROUGH THE DURATION OF THE FOUR SHOTS. AFTER THE SHOTS I HAD FIRED STRUCK THE DOG, THE DOG THEN LAYED ON THE SIDE OF THE ROAD, JUST OFF THE SIDEWALK. IT WAS APPARENT THAT THE DOG WAS DYING AND WAS SUFFERING GREATLY, TAKING SHALLOW BREATHS AND GASPING. I APPROACHED THE DOG AGAIN, FIRING TWO WELL AIMED SHOTS DIRECTLY INTO THE DOGS HEAD. THE DOG EXPIRED IMMEDIATELY. OFFICERS ADVISED LAURENS CENTRAL DISPATCH THAT SHOTS HAD BEEN FIRED AND THAT THE DOG HAD BEEN PUT DOWN DUE TO A THREAT TO THE SAFETY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC. AT THIS TIME THE OWNER OF THE DOG, JAMES ESTES, CAME FROM THE BACK OF THE RESIDENCE OF 113 GORDON ST ALONG WITH KAYLA CANFIELD. AN ELDERLY FEMALE OCCUPANT OPENED THE FRONT DOOR OF 113 GORDON ST STATED THAT SHE KNEW THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT WERE OUTSIDE, BUT DID NOT KNOW WHAT WAS GOING ON. ESTES AND CANFIELD WERE EXTREMELY UPSET THAT OFFICERS HAD BEEN FORCED TO EUTHANIZE THE DOG, AND DID NOT UNDERSTAND THAT THE AGGRESSIVE DOG WAS A THREAT TO NOT ONLY US BUT THE PUBLIC. ESTES AND CANFIELD BECAME VERY ARGUMENTATIVE. CANFIELD EVEN STATED THAT SHE WAS GOING TO SHOOT A DOG BELONGING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS. LT WICKER AND MYSELF BOTH ATTEMPTED TO DE-ESCALATE THE SITUATION WITH ESTES AND CANFIELD. ONCE BOTH PARTIES HAD SEEMINGLY CALMED DOWN, AND APPEARED TO UNDERSTAND THE NECESSITY FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT TO PROTECT THEMSELVES AND OTHERS, I RETURNED TO MY PATROL VEHICLE. I THEN ISSUED ESTES, THE OWNER OF THE DOG, A COURTESY SUMMONS FOR VIOLATION OF THE CITY DOG ORDINANCE / LEASH LAW. I EXPLAINED THE CITATION TO ESTES, WHO ADVISED THAT HE WOULD NOT PAY ANY FINE. I ADVISED ESTES THAT HE WOULD NEED TO ATTEND MUNICIPAL COURT ON THE APPOINTED DATE AND TIME. R/O CLEARED THE SCENE, NOTHING FURTHER.
